



Organizational Value-Add Strategy	Not Workforce Diversity – Human Resource Dimension to DEI
Growth of Customer Base	Not Affirmative Action
Cost Efficiency Driver	Not a Quota System
Self-Funding Practice	Not a Cost Burden
Contributes to Bottom Line/Net Income


